- ◆ Tour of **Arles**, highlighted by the Cathedral of St-Trophime and the Roman Amphitheater.

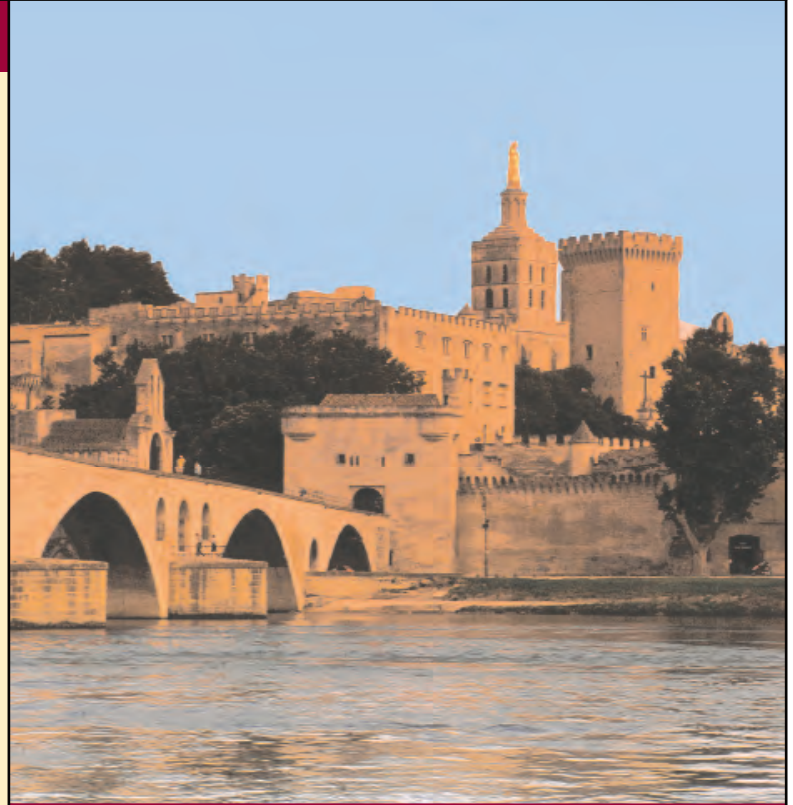
