

FULBRIGHT SCHOLARSHIP PRELIMINARY APPLICATION

Fulbright awards are based on both past accomplishments and the proposed plan of study abroad. The Office of Undergraduate Grants and Awards does not screen candidates, but rather evaluates the candidate on the basis of a completed application and interview. This evaluation becomes part of your application.

Students contemplating applying for a Fulbright Scholarship should register their intent to do so by **returning this application to the Office of Undergraduate Grants and Awards (SAC138) by Monday, September 17, 2007**. Interviews will be held on October 3, 2007.

Success in the Fulbright competition depends to a large degree on the specificity of the proposed plan of study. Letters of support from the institution with which you hope to affiliate are most helpful. Thus you should start as early as possible to design a program of study and to familiarize yourself with the country--and its resources--in which you intend to study.
