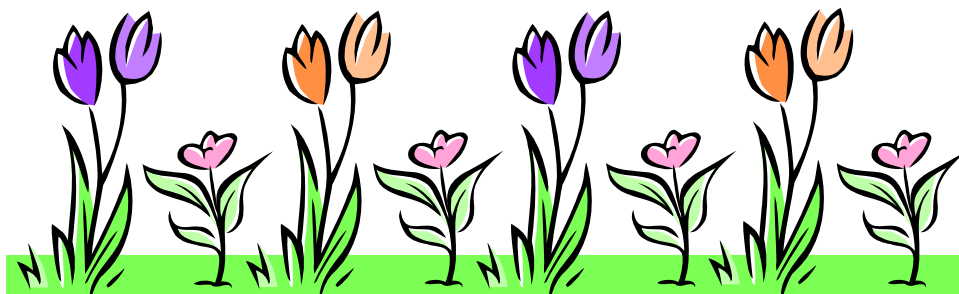
### Math Club

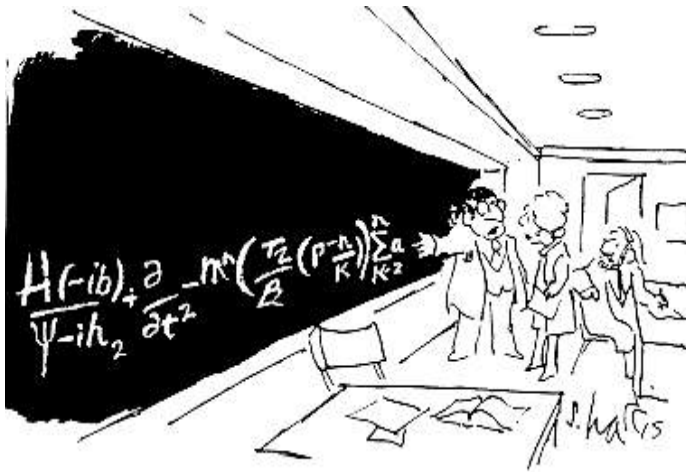

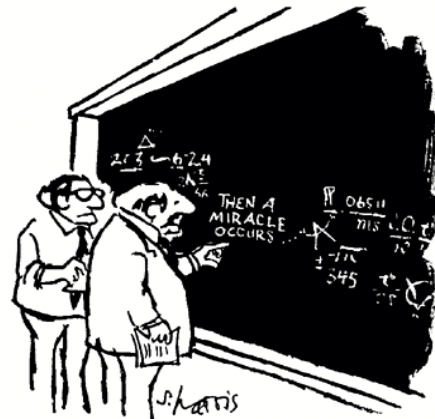
