VSB's Academic Year Business Minor Program is designed for fulltime undergraduates enrolled in other Villanova colleges. Students admitted to the program take classes with VSB students during the academic year. The program is administered by the Clay Center at VSB.

Course Requirements

- VSB 1000 – Information Technology¹ (1 cr., offered Fall only)
- VSB 1001 – Business Dynamics I¹ (3 cr., offered Fall only)
- VSB 1002 – Business Dynamics II¹ (3 cr., offered Spring only)
- ECO 1001 – Intro to Microeconomics (3 cr., offered Fall/Spring)
- ECO 1002 – Intro to Macroeconomics (3 cr., offered Fall/Spring)
- VSB 2010 – Financial Mgt & Reporting² (6 cr., offered Fall/Spring)
- VSB 2020 – Competitive Effectiveness³ (6 cr., offered Fall/Spring)
- Statistics: The statistics requirement may be fulfilled by the following:
 1. MAT1230 and MAT1235 OR
 2. VSB2005 and any calculus course OR
 3. MAT1430 and any calculus course OR
 4. BIO3105 and any calculus course OR
 5. MAT4310 (MAT1505 is a pre-req)

***The statistics requirement is waived for Engineer & Math majors**

FOOTNOTES:

1. VSB 1000; VSB 1001; and VSB 1002 must be taken in sequence and within the same academic year.
2. Prerequisites for VSB2010 are: VSB1000; VSB1001; VSB1002; ECO1001; and ECO1002. Statistics is a pre or co requisite for VSB2010.
3. Prerequisites for VSB 2020 are: VSB1000; VSB1001; VSB1002; ECO1001; and ECO1002.

VSB Course Descriptions

VSB 1000 Information Technology: On line course focusing on design and use of spread sheets to support decision making/problem solving. 1.00cr

VSB 1001 Business Dynamics I: Emphasis on purpose of business; how business vision is actualized. Explores dynamic nature of business in a changing environment. Highlights skills of leaders. Integrates global, ethical, & technological dimensions of business. Emphasizes innovation as a business and personal skill. 3.00cr

VSB 1002 Business Dynamics II: Continuation of Business Dynamics I. Contribution of business functions to accomplish business vision; cross functional view of business. Integrates global, ethical, technological & innovative dimensions of business and personal success. Action learning, problem-solving approach. 3.00cr

VSB 2010 Financial Management & Reporting: Foundation principles of corporate finance and financial accounting; emphasis on solving business problems. 6.00cr

VSB 2020 Competitive Effectiveness: Integration of marketing and management concepts as approach to creating value in business. 6.00cr

Business Minor students may earn an additional minor in the following: Accounting; Business Analytics; Economics; Entrepreneurship; Finance; International Business; Management Info Systems; Marketing; Real Estate. VSB approval and additional coursework is required.
