

The ADEA AADSAS application requires all applicants to provide a DENTPIN®, a unique identification number assigned to all applicants and students in dental education and standardized testing programs. You may have obtained a DENTPIN® when you registered for the DAT. If not, you will be prompted to register for a DENTPIN® when you create your ADEA AADSAS application. Your DENTPIN® will follow you throughout your dental education career and will be required to register for future examinations. The applicant should **not** provide the names of individual evaluators whose letters are appended to the committee letter. **List only** Dr. Russo

 Applicants may submit a maximum of four individual Letters of Evaluation or one <u>Committee</u> <u>Letter/Report plus the optional of</u> one additional individual letter.

 Evaluators have the option of submitting a letter <u>electronically</u> or by mailing a paper letter to ADEA AADSAS.

Letters must be sent from the evaluator directly to ADEA AADSAS.
