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Introduction

The Fall 2011 Enrollment Fact Book is presented as a comprehensive source of information regarding Villanova University's student population. The purpose of this book is to provide a consistent and full understanding of enrollment information. The Fact Book includes topics such as majors, geography, ethnicity, and retention for all students for Fall 2011.

Fall 2011 is the eleventh edition of the Enrollment Fact Book. A 4-year trend analysis is included.

Fall 2011 is the second year reporting Race/Ethnicity following new government guidelines. Citizenship, Race and Ethnicity are self reported. 2007 – 2009 data in the old format is available upon request.

Fall 2011 is the first year International Student information is being drawn directly from SEVIS data. This year in order to reduce the discrepancy between the number of non-citizens vs. the number of foreign countries, a hybrid report of addresses and country of citizenship from the GOASEVS (SEVIS) data in Banner was used.
