To receive consideration for the Federal Direct Loan, you must complete the steps listed below:

- Submit the 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1, 2012.
- Submit the 2012-2013 Villanova University BSN Express Institutional Financial Aid Application to Villanova by March 1, 2012. Note: If you have a question about your dependency status for financial aid, please contact the Office of Financial Assistance.
- We encourage you to use myNOVA to check on the completeness and status of your aid application.
- Students who complete the financial aid process by March 1st will hear about their award package by April 15th.

- All BSN Express Applicants must submit the 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1, 2012 and list code 003388. The FAFSA can be completed on the web at www.fafsa.gov.
- All BSN Express Applicants must complete this Villanova University Financial Aid Application and mail it to the Office of Financial Assistance by March 1, 2012.
- Make sure student's name and Villanova University Number are on the top of each document sent to our office.
- New for 2012-2013 Students and parents are encouraged to use the IRS Data Retrieval process when completing the FAFSA whenever possible. If not, we may require you to submit a 2011 Tax Return Transcript to verify your income prior to disbursement of funds to your student account.

NOTE: The Office of Financial Assistance reserves the right to utilize internet-based resources to verify information on the forms and to request Form 4506 for tax/income confirmation from the IRS if warranted during the file review.
