71% of people that volunteer say that they have an enjoyable experience.



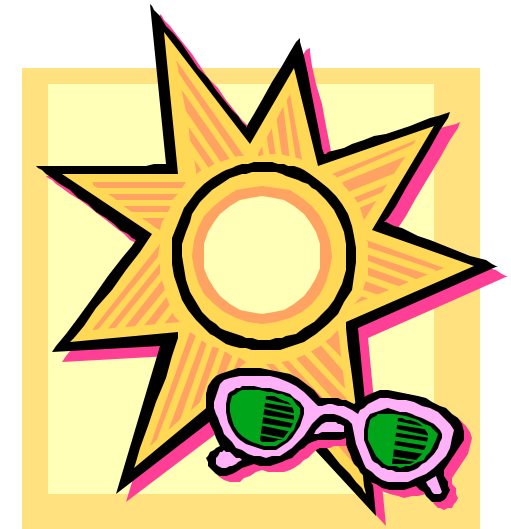

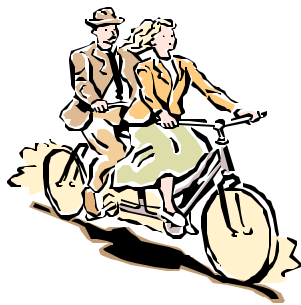
