

## BSN*EXPRESS* PROGRAM

**The following information is for students who have been accepted into the BSN*Express* Program beginning in May.**

Acceptance into this program is provisional based upon satisfactory completion of the following prerequisite courses prior to the start of classes in May and maintenance of at least a 3.0 GPA. Please have transcripts for completed prerequisites sent to the attention of Maryanne Lieb, Coordinator, BSN*Express* Program. All official transcripts must be received prior to students beginning their clinical placement in July.

**Anatomy and Physiology I and II (8 credits)**  
**Chemistry (3-4 credits; the course must have an organic component)**  
**Either Cell Biology, Genetics or Microbiology (3-4 credits)**  
**Nutrition (3 credits)**  
**Statistics (3 credits)**  
**Pathophysiology (3 credits)**  
**Religion (6 credits)**  
**Developmental Psychology (3 credits)**

**Several sections of Pathophysiology will be offered by the College of Nursing during the spring semester in both traditional classroom and online formats.** Please note, these sections have a limited number of seats. Students planning to complete this course (or other prerequisites) at Villanova will be doing so as part-time students through the Office of Part-Time Studies. There is a two step process to taking a course as a part-time student.

**If you have not already done so, you will need to complete the BSN*Express* version of the Part-Time Studies application since you will not be a matriculated student until May.** If you have not yet received the specific application to Part-Time Studies, please contact [susan.leighton@villanova.edu](mailto:susan.leighton@villanova.edu).
