Name of Subject: Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc.
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other administrative action taken
General Description of Violation: University received report of potential improper new member practices, including verbal and physical hazing activities.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Public Safety. Student Life took administrative action; organization was temporarily prohibited from operating and also required to complete numerous action steps in order to return to good standing.
Date Matter was Resolved: February 1, 2022

Name of Subject: Delta Gamma
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other administrative action taken
General Description of Violation: In June 2022, the University received a report of potential improper new member practices that took place in March 2022, including alcohol violations and verbal hazing activities.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Public Safety. Student Life took administrative action; organization was temporarily prohibited from operating and also required to complete numerous action steps in order to return to good standing.
Date Matter was Resolved: September 28, 2022

Name of Subject: Kappa Delta
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other organization action taken
General Description of Violation: In April 2023, the University was notified that Kappa Delta national headquarters had determined that chapter violated Kappa Delta policies on hazing and harm reduction.
Investigation and Findings: Student Life communicated with chapter regarding Kappa Delta national organization-imposed outcomes, which included review of new member education plans, oversight of education programs, and additional policy education requirements.
Date Matter was Resolved: April 12, 2023

Name of Subject: Sigma Chi
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other administrative action taken
General Description of Violation: University received report of potential improper new member practices, including verbal and physical hazing activities.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Public Safety and Student Life took administrative action. The organization was temporarily prohibited from operating during the investigation and, following investigation, organizational recognition was suspended until Spring 2028.
Date Matter was Resolved: December 8, 2023

Name of Subject: NROTC
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other administrative action taken
General Description of Violation: University received report of verbal and physical hazing activities.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Public Safety and NROTC took administrative action. NROTC imposed educational requirements and implemented new protocols and restrictions designed to address any areas of concern.
Date Matter was Resolved: January 21, 2025

Name of Subject: Phi Sigma Kappa
Date Subject Charged w/ Violation: N/A – other administrative action taken
General Description of Violation: University received report of hazing activities at organization event involving coerced consumption of alcohol and food items, together with allegations of sleep deprivation and potential academic misconduct.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Student Life. The organization was temporarily prohibited from operating during the investigation and, following investigation, organizational action steps and educational requirements were imposed.
Date Matter was Resolved: January 15, 2025

Name of Subject: Delta Chi Fraternity
General Description of Violation: University received report of potential improper new member practices involving required physical presence at a campus building in early morning hours.
Investigation and Findings: Matter was investigated by Public Safety, and the organization was temporarily prohibited from operating during the investigation. Following the investigation, the organization was charged under the Code of Student Conduct. The organization accepted responsibility and chapter operations were suspended pending a full membership review. Following the membership review the organization was placed on Disciplinary Probation. Organizational action steps and educational requirements were also imposed.
