**Welcome home!** As one of the first students to live on the Cabrini Campus, you're part of an exciting new chapter for Villanova University. This guide will provide everything you need to know for a smooth move-in and a great start in your new residence hall.

#### BEFORE YOU TRAVEL TO CAMPUS

- Log in to your housing portal to register for a date and time to arrive for Move-In Weekend. Pre-registration **is required** to help us minimize delays throughout the weekend.
- Visit our website to view important information about Move-In Weekend, including a campus map, driving directions and information about on-campus travel; a list of what to bring (and what not to bring); operating hours for campus buildings and services; details about package pickup; and much more!
- Beginning Friday, Aug. 7, you may ship packages to campus. Please label packages as follows:

When you arrive for move-in, you may visit the mailroom in Ortiz Hall to retrieve your packages and bring them to your residence hall.

- Help us manage waste by removing items from boxes before coming to campus.

#### ARRIVING AT THE CABRINI CAMPUS

- In this packet, you'll find a hang tag for your vehicle. It is important to bring this hang tag with you and display it from your rearview mirror as you arrive to campus. Only vehicles displaying this hang tag will be permitted to access areas near residence halls. Only one hang tag is available per student.
- When you arrive at your residence hall, please unload your belongings on the sidewalk as quickly as possible and check in with your RA at the main entrance.
- After unloading, staff will direct you to a parking area to allow for others to pull up to the hall and unload. Cars will not be permitted to park near residence halls throughout Move-In Weekend.
- Students with a Cabrini Campus parking permit will be required to park in the Dixon Center parking lot during Move-In Weekend until 6 p.m. on Sunday, Aug. 23. After 6 p.m. on Sunday, students with permits may park in their assigned lots.
- All vehicles must enter the Cabrini Campus via the King of Prussia Road entrance. Traffic will move in one direction throughout campus and will exit via Upper Gulph Road. Staff will be available to direct you to the exit.

- U-Hauls and other rental trucks will not fit into campus parking garages, and the use of these vehicles for move-in purposes is discouraged.
- Please remember to dispose of recycling and trash according to the posted signs in your building. If you have any questions, Residence Life staff members will be available to assist you.
